## I am the Lord that heals you.

- And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.  
Genesis 1:28
  - *The red blood cells of our body already obey this verse, as they multiply and replenished themselves every 80 - 120 days<sup>1</sup>! Look at the rest of what God said - subdue and have dominion... over every living thing! WOW! That includes cancer, bacteria, parasites, viruses and all microorganisms that cause sickness and disease.*
  - *He gave the blessing, He gave the command, He gave **you** the right - now do it. Put your foot down on sickness and disease and command it to go - it has no right to stay, you are a blood bought child of God! Don't put up with it another minute, **subdue and take dominion!***
- And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also *is* flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. Genesis 6:3
  - *The promise of God is that you live a good long life, even to 120 years if you so desire! Speak to that mountain of death and command it to be removed. Begin to grab hold of this promise of long life and lay claim to it with your spoken words. Don't settle for less than what God has promised, don't let the devil steal from you - go on and live a long life fulfilling your days, calling and ministry upon this Earth!*
- And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for **I am the LORD that healeth thee.** Exodus 15:26
  - *Do you get this "He heals you", not He might. **It is a done deal.***
- And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and **I will take sickness away from the midst of thee.** There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil. Exodus 23:25-26
  - *True worship is a heart condition and is a key to walking in divine health. It brings out humility of heart and opens the door for His life to flow (to flow in you and through you). Close every door to the devil that you are aware of. Take time each day to worship and love on God from your heart.*
- Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I *am* the LORD your God. Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I *am* the LORD. Leviticus 18:4-5
  - *The importance of walking in obedience to the Word of God is that **he shall live by them...** The key phrase: "**he shall live**" is only one word in the Hebrew language: **chayay.***

- *This word doesn't mean to sustain life, barely getting by, but literally means to live prosperously, with vitality, being free or revived from sickness, faintness, discouragement, and even death. It has the implied meaning of restoration, revival, and even growth or increase of well being. So, you are to **flourish** or to **thrive** in life to the fullest. If you apply yourself to the Word in obedience, you will flourish, thrive and increase in all areas of life! This not only includes healing and health but all other areas of our life as well.*
  
- Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle. And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all *them* that hate thee. Deuteronomy 7:14-15
  - *If this was a promise to God's covenant people under the Old Covenant, how much more does this benefit of health pertain to us today; as we are under the New Covenant which is based upon the precious Blood of Jesus Christ!*
  
- The secret *things belong* unto the LORD our God: but those *things which* are revealed **belong unto us and to our children for ever**, that we may do all the words of this law. Deuteronomy 29:29
  - *Healing and health belong to you and your family line. Healing has been revealed to us through the Word of God - declared to us through the shed covenant Blood of Jesus Christ on the cross. Every Scripture on this page is declaring your revealed covenant right. Dig in and take hold of it by faith and refuse to let go of your birthright!*
  
- I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, *that* I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live: That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, *and* that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. Deuteronomy 30:19-20
  - *Just as it was when this was spoken to the children of Israel, it is true for us today - we need to make up our minds and choose life. When we do, then we must adhere to the prescribed formula for that life: that you will love the LORD your God, that you will obey Him (Word & Voice), and that you will cling to Him. Fall in love with Jesus, fall in love with the Word - health and life will be a natural result! Praise the Lord.*
  
- There failed not ought of any good thing which the LORD had spoken unto the house of Israel; all came to pass. Joshua 21:45
  - *How much more sure is this promise to us since our covenant with God is based upon the shed Blood of Jesus Christ!*
  
- Blessed be the LORD, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant. 1 Kings 8:56

- *Not one word of God's promises have failed.*
- Thou shalt come to *thy* grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in in his season. Job 5:26
  - *Mature, full of life, healthy in all respects. You don't pick grain that is withered and dried up or damaged. Stand on His promises.*
- For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God. Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows. Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways. Job 22:26-28
  - *Claim the promises in the Word, they are your inheritance. Make a declaration "**I am healed!**" "Lord, you said that with your stripes I am healed, so on the authority of Your Word, I declare that I am healed and that sickness and disease have no legal right or hold on me and they must go in the Name of Jesus!"*
- O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me. Psalm 30:2
- Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. Psalm 35:27
  - *The word in the Hebrew for prosperity here is "shalom" and we know it as the word for peace. However, in the Hebrew this word literally means health, prosperity and peace - wholeness, welfare. So you can clearly see the mind of God who takes pleasure in the health, wholeness, prosperity and peace of us His children! He's excited for us to have it.*
- The LORD will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make all his bed in his sickness. Psalm 41:3
  - *The phrase "all his bed" in the Hebrew, has the meaning of; all that he is afflicted with, or all of his condition that he is lying with. It is always Gods' will to turn, change and transform our mourning into dancing - Psalm 30:11*
- Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. Psalm 42:11
- Blessed be the Lord, *who* daily loadeth us *with benefits*, even the God of our salvation. Selah. Psalm 68:19
  - *This is the heart of the Father toward us. His will is to bring us daily to the realization of His benefits for us. This scripture links benefits to salvation. The word here for salvation is the Hebrew word **Yeshuwah**, and it means deliverance, to give aid to, prosperity, victory and even includes health! This is a similar Hebrew word for the*

Name Jesus - **Yashua**, which means **He shall save**. And that is exactly what Jesus purchased for us on the cross - salvation, deliverance and wholeness... Insist on and receive your benefits today, they belong to you. Put your foot down on sickness and disease and command it to leave, in the name of Jesus Christ, it does not belong to you, it definitely is NOT a benefit and as such is not yours.

- The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away. Psalm 90:10
  - Many take this verse to be the cap that God has set for mankind's lifespan upon the earth. But nothing could be further from the truth. This psalm pertains to the disobedient children of Israel that came out of Egypt being led by Moses who, because of their unbelief, were condemned to live out their lives wandering in the desert until each one died. Only their children, along with Joshua and Caleb, would enter into the Promised Land. Moses went on to live to 120 years and the scripture says that his strength had not departed him and his eyes were not dim. He also was very able to climb the mountain God had commanded him to climb where he died. Joshua and Caleb also lived to be over 100. You're not an unbeliever, you're a believer! Expect long life.
- Because thou hast made the LORD, *which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; there shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling*. Psalms 91:9-10
- Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation. Psalms 91:14-16
  - Here God is saying live until you're satisfied! (Are you satisfied?)
- For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; to hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; Psalms 102:19-20
  - If you are born-again, then YOU are not appointed to death but to life in Christ Jesus. The Word tells us that He who the son sets free is free indeed! Take hold of and insist upon your covenant right of freedom today in Jesus' Name. Command the devil, sickness, disease, pain and suffering to GO in Jesus' Name - you have another appointment in Him, and that appointment is supernatural, overflowing, and abundant life in Jesus Christ our Lord.
  - You may feel like a prisoner because of your circumstance, but rejoice because God's will IS to LOOSE you from it. Praise Him for it.
- Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless his holy name*. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness

and tender mercies; who satisfieth thy mouth with good *things*;  
so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's. Psalms 103:1-5

- "You were healed". (Past tense) *Jesus paid it all for your total deliverance - spirit, soul and body! It's a done deal.*
- Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered *them* from their destructions. Psalms 107:19-20
- I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD. Psalms 118:17
  - *Agree with this right now! Declare it with your voice! God has a plan for your life here on Earth. Don't let the enemy steal it away. **You can do what God says you can do, you can be what God says you can be!***
- The LORD shall preserve (keep) thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul (life). The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore. Psalm 121:7-8
  - *Notice He said He would keep or preserve us from all evil. This includes sickness and disease. The word for preserve means to guard, to keep, to hedge about, to protect, and to attend to.*
  - *Praise the Lord! His will is to do this now and forevermore. Begin to thank Him and praise Him for it.*
- Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. Proverbs 3:7-8
  - *The term "fear the Lord" means to reverence and worship the Lord in all things.*
- My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it *are* the issues of life. Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee. Proverbs 4:20-24
  - **God's Word is life and medicine to your flesh**. *Prescribed medicine can help some things, but **God's medicine heals ALL**. "He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself ..." <sup>2</sup> [edify means to build in a literal sense, to instruct and improve the mind in knowledge generally, and particularly in moral and religious knowledge, in faith and holiness.] This is what you are doing for your being when you pray in the spirit.<sup>3</sup>*
- As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come. Proverbs 26:2
  - *As we continue in Christ, the curse has no right to take root in our lives. Take a firm stand against it, and command its effects to leave in the Name of Jesus! You are a child of the King.*
- And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity. Isaiah 33:24
  - *Forgiveness of their iniquity also provided for the healing of their bodies. How much more does this apply for us now in this time, having Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior, who has redeemed us from the curse of the Law being made a curse for us*

*(Galatians 3:13) who by His stripes we were healed (1 Peter 2:24), has made this scripture a reality to us (spiritual Zion) through His shed Blood on the cross!*

- But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31
  - *The word "wait" in this verse implies a positive action of hope, based on knowing that the Word of God is a true fact and that it will soon come to pass - waiting with earnest expectation! Hosea 12:6 "Act on the principles of love and justice, and always live in confident on your God" [Expectant Dependency] Hosea 16:12*
- Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. Isaiah 41:10
- I, *even* I, *am* he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins. Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified. Isaiah 43:25-26
  - *Your case was settled when Jesus went to the cross on your behalf! If you have accepted Jesus Christ as Lord then "It is finished!"*
- Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, *he* was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53:4-5
  - *The last part of this verse, "with His stripes we are healed," is not talking about spiritual healing, but definite physical healing. God does not "heal" a human spirit, he recreates it. He does however, heal our bodies and minds. This clearly shows that your healing was paid for at the cross! With here means we have to do something. You cannot go by someone to the store, you must go with them to the store. A physical act of accepting to go to the store a physical act of receiving healing.*
- No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue *that* shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness *is* of me, saith the LORD. Isaiah 54:17
  - *Sickness is judging you falsely; it's your birthright to live in health. You condemn it, with the Word of God, and command it to leave your body.*
- "So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." Isaiah 55:11 KJV
  - *God's Word on healing will accomplish healing in you.*
- "I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to him that is far off, and to him that is near", saith the LORD; and "I will heal him." Isaiah 57:19 KJV
  - *The word "fruit" here means produce. God creates what you produce from your mouth when we believe and speak out the Word of God. Amen, Praise God. Oh Yes, LORD!*



- Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward. Isaiah 58:8
- Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it. Jeremiah 1:12
  - *God is looking, searching eagerly for someone to take Him at His Word so that He can perform on their behalf. Amen! Praise the Lord. Thank you Jesus.*
- Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. Jeremiah 17:14
- Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces? Jeremiah 23:29
  - *The Word of God **IS** an all consuming fire that will melt away and burn off that which is not of God, and a powerful crushing force to break apart even the toughest and most stubborn circumstances. Continue taking the hammer of God's Word and continue to hit the situations in your life that are not of God, until they give way and become exactly as the Word says they should be. **Persistence breaks down resistance!***
- For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Jeremiah 29:11
  - *The word for peace here in Hebrew is the word shalom and implies the meaning of health and prosperity, which is obviously His will as it is the end or goal that the Lord is expecting for us. Begin to expect it - yes, that's right. Expectant Dependency Hosea 12:16*
- For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after. Jeremiah 30:17
  - *Claim it in the name of Jesus, daughter or son of Zion.*
- Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth. Jeremiah 33:6
  - *Praise God He will bring health, healing, abundance of peace and truth. Bring it Lord in the name of Jesus.*
- ...let the weak say, I am strong. Joel 3:10
  - *You are strong in Jesus Christ.*
- The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him. What do ye imagine against the LORD? He will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time. Nahum 1:7 & 9
  - *After you've received the manifestation of healing, this becomes your stand of faith!*
- But unto you that fear (reverence, worship) My name shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. You shall trample the wicked for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I do this says the Lord of hosts. Malachi 4:2-3 KJV

- *This verse is a great promise and even tells us when it became a reality for us. "On the day that I did this," was at Calvary. Now the enemy is as "ashes" under our feet and healing and protection belong to us. See Luke 10:19 also.*
- Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: **for every one that asketh receiveth**; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Matthew 7:7-8
  - *The word "ask" in the Greek has the meaning of insistent asking with a knowing of what belongs to the one making the request. Present a firm request to God, knowing He longs to distribute what He has to the one in need. Look at James 1:5-8 - we must ask in faith, and **faith always knows**, it never wishes!*
- And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed. Matthew 8:2-3
  - *Jesus is willing. Take Him at His word. "God does not lie". Titus 1:2*
- When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with *his* word, and **healed all that were sick**: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare *our* sicknesses. Matthew 8:16-17
  - *Find someone who believes God's Word regarding healing [not mind knowledge but heart knowledge - truly believes] and have them lay hands on you and pray for you in faith, based upon the promises of God.. James 5:16*
- ..."According to your faith be it unto you". Matthew 9:29
- "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden and I will give you to rest." Matthew 11:28
  - *The word 'rest' here literally means to cease from drudgery or labor in order to recover and collect his strength, and implies a feeling of wholeness and well being. Place your focus on Jesus and all that He has purchased for you. Take the focus off the circumstances, and begin praising Him for all that He has done for you. As a child of God, you are highly favored by God - He's given it all to you. Spend time each day just loving on God. **Come to Him through intimate worship, and experience this rest.** [The ease, the relief, and the refreshment for your souls.]*
- And great multitudes came unto him, having with them *those that were* lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel. Matthew 15:30-31
  - *Do you see - lame, blind, mute, maimed (body parts missing, cut off) and He healed them. All of them, not just some of them. Not just the easy cases, **all of them**.*
- Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again I say unto you, That if

two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven. Matthew 18:18-19

- *The prayer of agreement is powerful - have someone agree with you for your healing! The word "bind" means to forbid, the word "loose" means to let go or to allow to go free. Do not allow sickness, pain or disease run free in your body, bind it and forbid it to stay any longer because of your rights as a believer. Put your foot down and command it to leave in the Name of Jesus Christ!*
- Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, **If ye have faith, and doubt not,** ye shall not only do this *which is done* to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. **And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.** Matthew 21:21-22
  - *Do you get this? Ask & believe = DONE.*
- And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. Mark 11:22-24
  - *This includes healing. What kind of mountains or obstacles do you have in your life right now? Obey Jesus and command that mountain of pain, cancer, disease etc., to go **NOW** out of your body in the Name of Jesus. Jesus said you can have what you say. Begin to call your body whole, healed, well - don't stop, don't listen to your body, don't listen to doubt and fear, listen only to Jesus, **listen to His Word!** [We walk by faith and not by sight (or feeling).<sup>4</sup>]*
- And these signs shall follow them that believe; in my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. Mark 16:17-18
  - *Amen, so be it.*
- And the whole multitude sought to touch him: **for there went virtue (power / life) out of him, and healed them all.** Luke 6:19
  - *Praise God, thank you Jesus.*
- And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick. Luke 9:2
  - *And heal the sick. And heal the sick! AND HEAL THE SICK!*
- Behold, I give unto you power (authority) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over **all** the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19
  - *This is an exciting verse as Jesus said He has given us authoritative power over ALL, not some, of the enemy but all! Command Satan to take his hands off of you. Command sickness and disease to leave you in the Name of Jesus.*
- Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Luke 12:32
  - *Along with the kingdom, come all of the kingdom blessings and benefits! Realize that it gives God pleasure to give to you, after all He is a giver - He is love and love gives. So cast off fear, and put a smile on your face. You are rich in Him. Just receive it.*

- And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day? Luke 13:16
- It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing; the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. John 6:63
  - *God's Word **IS** healing; it will bring health to your flesh. See Proverbs 4:22. That's why it is so important to continue to go over the healing scriptures daily, building your faith in the area of healing, imparting the very life of God into your cells as well as your mind. Fill up on God's Word! ["He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself ..." 1 ]*
- If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. John 15:7
  - *Ask and it will be done for you.*
- "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:32
  - *The Word of God is truth "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your Word is Truth." 5 Once you know the truth concerning healing in God's redemptive plan, then you can begin to exercise faith and expect the promises of God to manifest in you - and they will - REJOICE!*
- If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. John 8:36
  - *The Greek thought here is **not just free, but undeniably and unquestionably free.** The Amplified version reads: "So if the Son liberates you [makes you free men], then you are really and unquestionably free."*
  - *Let this truth of victory soak down deep into your heart, marinade in it and chase away all thoughts of doubt and fear. Praise God, sickness and disease have no right to be in us, they cannot stay, and they have to go! Shout it out - "I'm a free!"*
- The thief (Satan) cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I (Jesus) am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. John 10:10
  - *Here we see the desired will of the Lord for every believer - **that we experience abundant life.** According to this verse He came for this very purpose. We also see clearly that it is not God who afflicts us. The word here for **life** is the Greek word "zoe". Life is being the highest and best of that which Christ is. In light of that meaning, you can easily see the wonderful gift of life the Lord wants for each of us. Sickness and disease are truly not in His plan for us.*
- There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one. Acts 5:16
- How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him. Acts 10:38
  - *Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever. He is still doing good and healing all who are oppressed by the devil. Are you oppressed by the devil and need healing? Ask Him. His answer is Yes and so be it.*
- Therefore *it is* of faith, that *it might be* by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham;

- who is the father of us all, (as it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, *even* God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: he staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. Romans 4:16-21
- *We must believe what God promises He will perform.*
  - For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness **shall reign in life** by one, Jesus Christ.) Romans 5:17
    - *It says you **will** reign in life [this life is in the here and now]. Are you reigning in life or are you being rained on? If you are not experiencing victory, know that it is a breach of the Word of God for it to remain and become the norm. Get mad, with a righteous indignation, and command the circumstances to leave and take hold of the victory that is yours through the Word. For this is the will of God!*
  - For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. Romans 8:2
    - *You are free from death of every part of your being inside and out and the effects of death and the curse!*
  - But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you. Romans 8:11
  - What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us. Romans 8:31
    - *You are victorious through the Lord Jesus Christ. Begin to see yourself the way God sees you.*
  - He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Romans 8:32
    - *This includes healing!*
  - So then faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. Romans 10:17
    - *Faith for healing comes by hearing God's Word concerning healing. So just as you may be taking medicine two or three times a day, do the same thing with the promises in the Word of God regarding healing, and allow your faith to be built! You'll be amazed at the change that will take place.*
  - For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance. Romans 11:29
    - *He's the **giver** of gifts and He doesn't take them back, they cannot be canceled out!*
  - God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. 1 Corinthians 1:9

- *The word "fellowship" is a strong covenant word in the original Greek text. It means: intimacy, partnership and participation, and is also the word for communion. Because we are born-again, we have been given the right to share intimately, in partnership and participation in His life. Know that He is life, the purest form of life, and He's called us to share intimately in it with Him. It's a place where sickness and disease have no right. This is your birthright, count on it and expect it. God is faithful. He's faithful to His Covenant Word, and to His covenant people, He's faithful to YOU!*
- Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours; whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours; 1 Corinthians 3:21-22
  - *This says it so clearly; the Lord is holding nothing back from us. Surely healing is included in the claim of "all things" and certainly is included in the word "life." Begin to praise the Lord for your healing which is a gift to you from the Lord, and the manifestation that will come as you receive the promise by faith.*
- Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make *them* the members of an harlot? God forbid. <sup>16</sup>What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. 1 Corinthians 6:15-17
  - *You are one with Jesus Christ now. Sickness has no right to Him, so it has no legal right to you. It is illegal and off limits, it has no right to stay. Take a firm stand and run off the attack and the lies of the enemy. You belong to the Lord; you are washed in His precious Blood, the covenant Blood. Command sickness and disease to leave; insist on your covenant rights just as the Word says it should be!*
- For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us. 2 Corinthians 1:20
  - *Yes and so be it.*
- "Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty." 2 Corinthians 3:17
  - *If you are born-again, if you've asked Jesus to come into your heart, then you are saved, you are a child of God and the Spirit of God dwells within your heart - make no mistake about it! According to this Scripture, freedom and liberty from bondage **in any form** belong to you, and you should expect it. It's your covenant right. Receive this personally as the truth that it is for you right now! Lift your hands to the Lord and begin to praise Him and worship Him for His goodness.*
- Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. For we which live are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh. 2 Corinthians 4:10-11
  - *Does Jesus walk around in sickness or disease? No and neither should you. He wants to manifest himself in our mortal bodies, in our flesh. He wants to perform His word in you. As He is so are we.*

- For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; 2 Corinthians 10:3-5
  - *Keep your focus on the promises of God - you have to make yourself stay focused. God's Word tells us that we should only think on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, having any virtue and praiseworthy.* <sup>6</sup> *Look closely at this scripture reference there is a very important word in this scripture "and" which means whatever thought you are thinking must fit all of these categories.*
- Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree: <sup>14</sup> that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. Galatians 3:13-14
  - *The curse of the law includes sickness and disease and is found in Deuteronomy 28:15-68. The first 14 verses of the chapter pertain to the blessing, and the rest of the chapter describes the curse! By the shed Blood of Jesus Christ we were purchased out of or out from under the curse! Especially look at verse 61, it states: "**all sickness and all disease in the world, even those not written in the Book, (is included in the curse)**" - so we are redeemed from it all through the blood of Jesus Christ!*
- And if ye *be* Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. Galatians 3:29
- Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; and your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Ephesians 6:10-18
  - *"He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself ..."* <sup>1</sup>
  - *Builds himself/herself up.*
- For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. Philippians 2:13
- Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, of good report, having any virtue, and praiseworthy, think on these things. Those things, which you have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you. Philippians 4:6-9

- *Why think on these things? We are to take every thought captive and subject it to the obedience of Jesus Christ.* <sup>7</sup>
- Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: Colossians 1:13
  - *To be conveyed (translated) is to be transferred, removed out of one and placed into another. The power of darkness which includes the curse, no longer has a hold on us as we are now members of a different kingdom - the Kingdom of God, which is the Kingdom of Life! There is no sickness and no disease in the kingdom of God. This is another wonderful scripture proving your birthright of healing.*
- But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him. 1 Thessalonians 5:8-10
  - *While this block of Scripture is talking about end times and the rapture of the Church, it is important not to miss the heart of God toward us the Church, which is constant and never changing. The curse does not belong to us, we were not appointed to it, we are appointed to the blessing which is the life of Christ given to us. The Word salvation always implies healing, mending, health as well as deliverance. One should always translate the word salvation as **saved-healed!** Don't miss this great truth, the Lord wants you to obtain healing.*
- "And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly [completely]; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless [sound, complete and intact] unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." 1 Thessalonians 5:23
  - *It is very clear in this passage that wholeness, wellness, and health are for our complete person (spiritual, mental, and physical).*
- For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. 2 Timothy 1:7
  - *Fear comes from none other than the father of lies, the devil. Do not believe him.* <sup>8</sup>
- All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 2 Timothy 3:16
  - *Does your body and/or mind need correction? God's Word is just the tool for correction and discipline. According to this verse, we see that it is His will that you may be complete and thoroughly equipped for every good work. If you are sick you cannot fully do the work of the ministry- know that God wants you to be able bodied, a living example in every area of His grace, mercy and power.*
- Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) Hebrews 10:23
  - *Remember God's Word says that it is impossible for God to lie!* <sup>9</sup>
- Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.<sup>36</sup> For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. Hebrews 10:35-36
  - *Remember that the will of God **IS** the Word of God!*



- Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised. Hebrews 11:11
- Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; and make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. Hebrews 12:12-13
  - *Real faith rejoices at the promises of God. Get the focus off of your problem and on to the answer which are the promises of God - His Word. REJOICE! Get happy, it's all yours!*
- Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Hebrews 13:8 KJV
  - *His promises are still His promises. He is the same yesterday, today and forever.<sup>10</sup>*
- Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, Hebrews 13:20
  - *The author of Hebrews is praying a blessing in accordance with the will of God for completeness and wholeness which is intended through the Blood Covenant. May you be strengthened, be made complete and be perfected, be made **what you ought to be** (because of the shed Blood) and equipped with everything good so you can accomplish His will! Wow!*
  - *This absolutely includes healing, health and wholeness. Our God has a purpose and a plan for you and He wants you to accomplish it now in Jesus' Name! That is His will, rise up and believe it, receive it and act upon it!*
- Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. James 1:17
  - *Healing is a wonderful gift from God, and here again is another proof that He does not change. What He did yesterday He will do again today - Praise the Lord, He is still the Healer!*
- For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body. Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body. Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasts great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindles! And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind: James 3:2-7
  - *We too must direct our thoughts and mouths and subject them to the obedience of Jesus Christ.*
- Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7
  - *Too often we just roll over for the devil. Get up and fight the good fight.*
- Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms. Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing

him with oil in the name of the Lord: and the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. James 5:13-16

- *Do not be anointed by an elder that prays the prayer of faithlessness. These kinds of prayers will fuel the attacks on your mind and body. If there aren't any elders you know that truly believe, then contact us by any means and we will pray for you.*
- Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. 1 Peter 2:24
  - **"You were healed".** (Past tense) *Jesus paid it all for your total deliverance – soul, spirit, body and emotions! All you need to do is accept it, in the same way you would accept any other gift. **Receive it.***
- According as his divine power **hath given** unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. 2 Peter 1:3-4
  - **"Has"** (Past tense) given us all things that pertain to life! *The blessing of health was purchased for us at the cross, it belongs to you now. Notice the importance of the Word of God - the precious promises. Your healing must be rooted unfalteringly on the Word (in Jesus Christ), **not on what you see or how you feel.** Also, we are partakers of His divine nature! I guarantee that His nature is total health and well being. Expect it! Accept it! "We walk by faith and not by sight" <sup>3</sup>*
- ... For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil. 1 John 3:8
  - *The reason the Son of God was made manifest [visible] was to undo [destroy, loosen, and dissolve] the works of the devil. There is no doubt that sickness and disease are works of the devil, introduced to mankind through the fall as part of the curse. This Scripture is very clear that Jesus came to undo the works of the devil. Be assured that He accomplished His task- further proof that sickness and disease have no legal right to remain in your body as a child of God! **Command it to go in Jesus Name!***
- . . . . Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. 1 John 4:4 **AMEN**
  - *Is He (Jesus Christ) in you? We can have head knowledge of God, of Christ, of the Holy Spirit but until we have heart knowledge, we are only fooling ourselves, that we know Christ. If you have heart knowledge of the God head, Praise the Lord all things for you are "Yes and Amen". <sup>11</sup>*
- Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because **as he is, so are we in this world.** 1 John 4:17
  - *Not only can we have boldness in the day of judgment, but we can have boldness now in this life, in the face of adversity, knowing who we are in Christ, knowing what belongs to us in Him and purposefully holding onto it, refusing what the enemy wants*

us to have. **As He is, so are we in this world.** Think about that for a moment ... , how is He now? Is He sick? NO! Is He diseased? NO! - it can't touch Him, and we are His body - the body of Christ. Insist on having the blessing of the Lord manifested in you - praise Him for it now, worship Him!

- For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. 1 John 5:4
  - In John 17:14 Jesus states that we as believer's are not of the world. Sickness, disease and failure belong to the world. As a believer, we are given the right to overcome that which comes against us by holding fast to the Word of God. While we do not deny that the problem or circumstance exists, we do however deny it the right to stay through our faith in God and His Word! Know this: **Faith in God is victory all of the time!**
  - You don't have to be a mountain of faith, you only have to believe what Jesus said is true and have faith in His Faith. "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: **and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God,** who loved me, and gave himself for me." Galatians 2:20 Nothing happens in you, it is in Him. I can't make sickness, disease, death or anything else flea. **Only God can.** Jesus said "If you ask for anything **in my name,** I will do it".<sup>12</sup> So, **ASK!** You can't make it go away but Jesus can.
- And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: and if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him. 1 John 5:14-15
  - The Word of God is the will of God. If you can find it in the Word of God, then you can be assured that it is the will of God. AMEN! The Lord is not trying to keep healing from you; He is trying to get it to you - **Just Believe!** It's easy to know the will of God. The Word of God is the will of God! God says " I am ready to perform My word" <sup>13</sup>
  - **So when you ask Him, and believe the Word of God, you are asking and believing according to His will and you will receive.**
- Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth. 3 John 1:2
- And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11
  - When your healing manifests itself and you recover and have the opportunity to testify to the grace of the Lord - **Do it!** The Lord wants you to give glory to Him for what He has done and it will also serve to help the faith walk in someone else who has a need.

According to an article in the Journal of Health and Social Behavior by Rutgers University "...people who rate their own health to be "poor" are five times more likely to die than those who rate their health as "excellent." <sup>14</sup> They were all in comparable health. The Word of God tells us "...**as he thinks in his heart, so is he.**" <sup>15</sup>

Take these scriptures, copy them, and study them daily. Read them many times a day. Feed on them. Put them into your mind until they get down into your heart... until they are Rhema to you. They will become bigger than any report the Doctor could give. Greater is He that is in you than He that is in this world! <sup>16</sup> **Your life many depend upon it.**

**Conclusion:**

**Do you need a touch from God?  
Healing: Physical, Emotional, Mental, or Spiritual**

**God's Answer is Yes & Amen.**

*Then said the LORD unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it. Jeremiah

*And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:22*

*If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. John 14:14*

Corinthians 1:20*

**These scriptures proclaim to us that the Lord is sitting on the edge of His seat, waiting for us to ask; if we ask and believe, in the name of Jesus, for one of His promises, we will receive it.**

**His answer to that prayer is "Yes" and "So be it".**

**Do you want your prayers answered "Yes" every time? Know His promises, ask in the name of Jesus and believe, and you will receive an answer of "Yes & Amen".**
