Follow the example at the top in **bold** to start your defense, then locate the type of thought and use the Word.

At the noise of the tumult the people fled; at the lifting up of yourself the nations were scattered.

Joel 2

Blow you the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD comes, for it is nigh at hand; A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there has not been ever the like, neither will be any more after it, even to the years of many generations.

A fire devours before them; and behind them a flame burns: the land is as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing will escape them. The appearance of them is as the appearance of horses; and as horsemen, so will they run.

Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains will they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devours the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array. Before their face the people will be much pained: all faces will gather blackness. They will run like mighty men; they will climb the wall like men of war; and they will march everyone on his ways, and they will not break their ranks:

Neither will one thrust another; they will walk everyone in his path: and when they fall upon the sword, they will not be wounded. They will run to and fro in the city; they will run upon the wall, they will climb up upon the houses; they will enter in at the windows like a thief.

The earth will quake before them; the heavens will tremble: the sun and the moon will be dark, and the stars will withdraw their shining: And the LORD will utter his voice before his army: for his camp is very great: for he is strong that executes his word: for the day of the LORD is great and very terrible; and who can abide it?

Therefore also now, says the LORD, turn you even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn to the LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repents him of the evil.

Who knows if he will return and repent, and leave a blessing behind him; even a meat offering and a drink offering to the LORD your God? Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare your people, O LORD, and give not your heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them: wherefore should they say among the people, Where is their God?

Then will the LORD be jealous for his land, and pity his people. Yea, the LORD will answer and say to his people, Behold, I will send you corn, and wine, and oil, and you will be satisfied therewith: and I will no more make you a reproach among the heathen: But I will remove far off from you the northern army, and will drive him into a land barren and desolate, with his face toward the east sea, and his hinder part toward the utmost sea, and his stink will come up, and his ill savour will come up, because he has done great things.

Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things. Be not afraid, you beasts of the field: for the pastures of the wilderness do spring, for the tree bears her fruit, the fig tree and the vine do yield their strength. Be glad then, you children of Zion, and rejoice in the LORD your God: for he has given you the former rain moderately, and he will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month.

And the floors will be full of wheat, and the vats will overflow with wine and oil. And I will restore to you the years that the locust has eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you. And you will eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, that has dealt wondrously with you: and my people will never be ashamed. And you will know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God, and none else: and my people will never be ashamed.

And it will come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit.

And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun will be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the LORD come.

And it will come to pass, that whosoever will call on the name of the LORD will be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem will be deliverance, as the LORD has said, and in the remnant whom the LORD will call.

Acts 16:24-26

Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks. And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises to God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

1 Samuel 16:14-23

But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. And Saul's servants said to him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubles you. Let our lord now command your servants, which are before thee, to seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp: and it will come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he will play with his hand, and thou shalt be well.

And Saul said to his servants, Provide me now a man that can play well, and bring him to me. Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD is with him.

Wherefore Saul sent messengers to Jesse, and said, send me David your son, which is with the sheep. And Jesse took an ass laden with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent them by David his son to Saul.

And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armor bearer. And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he has found favor in my sight.

And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

Isaiah 10:27

And it will come to pass in that day, that his burden will be taken away from off your shoulder, and his yoke from off your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing.

Luke 22:31-32

And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: But I have prayed for thee, that your faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen your brethren.

Deuteronomy 11:22-25

For if you will diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, and to cleave to him;

Then will the LORD drive out all these nations from before you, and you will possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves. Every place where on the soles of your feet will tread will be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the river Euphrates, even to the uttermost sea will your coast be.

There will no man be able to stand before you: for the LORD your God will lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that you will tread upon, as he has said to you.

Deuteronomy 28:1-7

And it will come to pass, if thou shall hearken diligently to the voice of the LORD your God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command you this day, that the LORD your God will set you on high above all nations of the earth:

And all these blessings will come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shall hearken to the voice of the LORD your God.

Blessed shall thou be in the city, and blessed shall thou be in the field.

Blessed will be the fruit of your body, and the fruit of your ground, and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your kin, and the flocks of your sheep.

Blessed will be your basket and your store.

Blessed will you be when you come in, and blessed will you be when you go out.

The LORD will cause your enemies that rise up against you to be smitten before your face: they will come out against you one way, and flee before you seven ways.

Psalms 91

He that dwells in the secret place of the most high will abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. Surely he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings shall thou trust: his truth will be your shield and buckler. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that fly by day; Nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness; nor for the destruction that waste at noonday.

A thousand will fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it will not come nigh thee.

Only with your eyes shall thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, your habitation; there will no evil befall you, neither will any plague come nigh your dwelling.

For he will give his angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. They will bear you up in their hands, lest thou dash your foot against a stone. You will tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon will you trample under feet.

Because he has set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known my name. He will call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

Ephesians 4:26-28

Be you angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: Neither give place to the devil. Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labor, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that need.

Ephesians 6:11-14

Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Wherefore take to you the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

Deuteronomy 20:1

When thou goes out to battle against your enemies, and sees horses, and chariots, and a people more than thou, be not afraid of them: for the LORD your God is with thee, which brought you up out of the land of Egypt.

2 Chronicles 20:15

And he said, Hearken you, all Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus says the LORD to you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.

Colossians 2:15

And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.
