

In the Church

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:38

You shall receive. Shall is the strongest word available to indicate that something will take place in the English language. There is no stronger word that can be used then the word shall.
